Notice to investors

Continuous Disclosure Notice (updated fees and costs) for Schroder Multi-Asset Income Fund – Wholesale Class

We are writing to inform investors, as the responsible entity for the Schroder Sustainable Multi-Asset Income Fund – Wholesale Class (**Fund**), that we have assessed that the amounts disclosed in section 6 (Fees and Costs) of the product disclosure statement for the Fund (**PDS**) need to be updated based on amounts paid in the 12 months ending 30 June 2024. We have formed the view that the changes to the fees and costs disclosed in the PDS are not materially adverse to investors. Therefore, the fees and costs amounts are being provided to investors through this website disclosure rather than by issuing a new PDS. Accordingly, all references to fees and costs in section 6 of the PDS dated 14 December 2023, are to be read based on the amounts in the tables below.

Potential investors should read the PDS and this update in its entirety. Capitalised terms have the same meaning as in the PDS, unless stated otherwise.

Fees and costs

Did you know?

Small differences in both investment performance and fees and costs can have a substantial impact on your long-term returns. For example, total annual fees and costs of 2% of your investment balance rather than 1% could reduce your final return by up to 20% over a 30-year period (for example, reduce it from \$100,000 to \$80,000). You should consider whether features such as superior investment performance or the provision of better member services justify higher fees and costs. You may be able to negotiate to pay lower fees. Ask the Fund or your financial adviser.

Schroders' reasonable estimate of the performance fee is based on (as applicable): (i) the average fee incurred for the previous five financial years; or (ii) if the interposed vehicle was not in operation for the past five financial years, the average fee incurred for all of the financial years in which the interposed vehicle was in operation; or (iii) if the interposed vehicle was first offered in the current financial year, Schroders' reasonable estimate of the fee for the current financial year adjusted to reflect a 12-month period. Past performance is not a reliable indicator of future performance and the performance fee will be based on the performance of the interposed vehicles over the relevant period. Additional explanation of fees and costs

Maximum fees

The maximum fees that Schroders is entitled to charge are set out in the Constitution.

The maximum management fee for the Fund under the Constitution is 5.13% (inclusive of GST and less any RITCs) per annum of the NAV of the Fund. The current management fee is 0.60% (inclusive of GST and less any RITCs) per annum of the NAV of the Fund.

Further information on the other maximum fees that Schroders is entitled to charge under the Constitution is set out in section 3 of the 'Additional information to the PDS'.

Fee changes

In practice, actual investment balances will vary daily and the actual fees and costs charged are based on the value of the Fund, which also fluctuates daily.
